Filling (gold), minimum	\$ 3
(All fillings offering more than ordinary difficulty, or taking more than 35 minutes of time, to be charged at the rate of \$5 per hour, value of gold added)	
Fillings – cement	\$ 2
Fillings – amalgam	\$ 2 – 3
Fillings – porcelain	\$ 5
Professional visits	\$ 3
Appointments missed	\$ 3
All other services, such as filling or dressing of teeth, repairing fillings, or removal of tartar, at the rate of \$5 per hour
