According to recent findings, the original owner was Francis Sturdevant and it was built sometime between 1870-1875.

The available Federal Census records for 1920-1940, Clarence Pitkin, Jr, and his wife Edith lived there and raised their two sons: Norman and Courtney. They were actually renting the house during that time. Clarence and Edith were married in 1916 and presumably took up residence there at that time. Edith died in 1988 and Clarence died in 1996.

A family by the name of Ray Balongue lived there from around 1956-1970. Not sure if they were renting or actually bought the house.

Ricky L. Lafever said that he lived there 13 years ago (around 2005) but he did not say how long he had lived there. He did mention that the back bathroom in the house was originally a bedroom before he moved there.

Perhaps a check with the Register of Deeds might be able to provide a bit more information.
