








5. Leddick - Reed, 8679 Sheridan c 1860. Simple Michigan farm style with interesting gables.











Kennedy 8710 Sheridan c 1875
 Queen Anne style with art glass, scalloped shingles. Bric-a-brac is Carpenter Gothic.












16. Van Kerin c 1865. 523 South Division. Replica of home in Mt. Morris, New York. Was relative of Ruggles family


WHITE LAKE AREA HISTORICAL SOCIETY
