










Murray's Inn postcard, circa 1909

Timeline for the Murray Family and Murray's Inn:

1870	William Murray is born to John and Hannah Sullivan Murray
1875	The White River Light Station is built, and Annabel Margaret Robinson is born to Captain William Robinson and his wife Sarah Cooper Robinson
1892-1897	William Murray is a member of the United States Life-Saving Service (U.S.L.S.S.) Beacon article "Lysaght" September 15, 2024 by Barbara Bedau Brow states that William Murray joined the Life Saving crew at the White River Station in March of 1892, and the same article lists William a second time as a member of the crew on April 1, 1895
1896	William Murray and Annabel Margaret Robinson are married on November 25th, 1896
1898-1907	William Murray is working as an assistant keeper at the White River Light Station for his father-in-law Captain William Robinson (Reference: J. Candace Clifford Lighthouse Research Catalog)
1900-1907	William Murray is working as an assistant keeper at the White River Light Station for Captain Robinson from April 1900 to December 1907 (Reference: White River Light Station by Thomas A. Tag)
1898	William and Annabel's 1st child William "Leo" Murray is born
1899	William and Annabel's 2nd child Susie Murray is born
1900	At the turn of the 20th century, William, Annabel, Leo and Susie are living and/or working at the White River Light Station with Captain Robinson
1904	William Murray starts a boat livery business
1908	William and Annabel open the original Murray's Inn (building #1)
1910	William and Annabel's 3rd child Mary Murray is born
1914	William and Annabel's 4th child James Murray is born

1915	The KUM-ON-IN is built (also known as building #4 at the pier)
1920	William and Annabel's 5th and youngest child Helen Murray is born
1922	The Main Building is built (also known as building #2)
1930	Leo Murray marries Veronica (Vee) Dennis on December 27th
1936	Mary Ellen Murray marries J. R. "Doc" Janney
1939	Murcrum Lodge is built and Mary Lee Murray, Leo and Veronica's second daughter is born on September 20th
1944	William retires and his son Leo takes over the management of Murray's Inn
1947	The Glo-Mar Lodge building (from the Sylvan Beach Hotel) is purchased by Leo for \$1,000 and moved over the road and down the hill to Murray's Inn
1950	Annabel Murray passes away on July 13th
1953	Building #4 is removed, and the White Lake beach is expanded for the 1954 summer season. The top floor is spared, moved to the Glo-Mar section, and called the Glo-Mar Cottage
1957	The "New Deluxe Brick" Glo-Mar Hotel is built
1960s	Leo's cousin Budd Murray and his wife Amy join the resort operation
1961	William Murray passes away
1969	James Murray passes away
1972	Murray's Inn is divided and sold, with Leo Murray and his family retaining certain cottages and the Lake Michigan beach property
